## DECORATORS WEIGH IN ON FITTING A COFFEE TABLE TO YOUR SOFA

How far apart should the two pieces be? "I don't like to be rigid," says Steven Sclaroff, "but it is nice to be able to maneuver around and rest a drink on the table. Eighteen inches usually does the trick."

What's the right table length? "Scale is everything," says Nancy Corzine. "I usually like six inches on each side. A slender, six-foot table tends to work with a seven-foot sofa. If the table is bulky, I'd go with a five-foot version."
