he condominium gleams and glows like a faceted jewel. Rich in exotic woods, it is 3,100 square feet of riveting design. Lustrous textures abound, counterpointing maple wood inlaid floors, while color tones ranging from light beige to deep chocolate keep the emphasis on architectural detailing.
